THE BUGS IN OUR LIFE

As we cruise down the pike on our bikes we are exposed to bugs. Unlike those who ride in a car, (a locked tin box).

Most bugs are just messy, *splat on your face guard, or the windshield*. But there are those that can hurt you. Picture the guy who had a bee hit him on the chest. The bee then crawled up inside the face guard of his helmet and sat on his nose! The bee was happy to get out of the wind.

This bee can kill you. In the US bees kill 10 times more people than poisonous snakes. The sting is not the worse problem. Keeping the bike under control is.

If you're stung by a bee, don't pull out the stinger with your fingers. That will squeeze out any venom left. Instead, scrape it off with a knife or credit card.

A paste of unseasoned meat tenderizer applied to the area helps. It contains an enzyme called papain, which works by breaking down proteins like bee venom.

Icing stings helps by slowing the blood flow to the area, limiting the spread of venom and decreasing the chance of a systemic reaction.

The bugs that really are bad news are the *LOVE BUGS*. No one is happy when they have to clean a bike after a ride thru a cloud of those little mating pairs.

When you're off the bike and walking around, you can still get some disease. Malaria. Beware of mosquitoes. This disease has mostly been eliminated in the US.

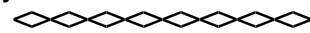

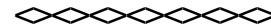

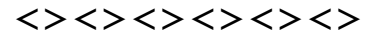
